AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE SIMPSON COUNTY, KENTUCKY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE

WHEREAS, pursuant to KRS 68.005(2), the county judge/executive has prepared and submitted an amendment to the Simpson County Administrative Code as hereinafter set forth; and;

WHEREAS, the Simpson Fiscal Court approves said amendments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF THE COUNTY OF SIMPSON, COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY, after the passage, approval, and publication of this ordinance.

Section 360.15 of the Simpson County, Kentucky Administrative Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

360.15 If accepted by the county as a regular full-time employee at the end of the probationary period, the employee's sick leave and vacation time shall accrue from the first day worked. Eligibility for any and all other employee benefits shall become effective the date said employee is permanently employed at the end of the probationary period. Provided, however, the Fiscal Court may, by resolution, elect to allow any and all employee benefits to become effective from the first day worked of the probationary period.

2. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in

conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.
