

ORDINANCE NO. 310.10

**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 310.3
RELATING TO THE LEVY OF A FLAT RATE CHARGE OF \$250.00
FOR FIRE RUNS MADE FOR THE BENEFIT OF PROPERTY OWNERS
LOCATED IN SIMPSON COUNTY, KENTUCKY AND PROVIDING
FOR A LIEN TO SECURE THE PAYMENT OF SAME**

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 310.3 adopted June 11, 1996, the Simpson Fiscal Court levied a flat rate charge of \$250.00 for fire runs made for the benefit of property owners located in Simpson County, Kentucky and provided for a lien to secure the payment of same; and,

WHEREAS, the Simpson Fiscal Court has determined that said ordinance should be repealed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF THE COUNTY OF SIMPSON, COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY, after the passage, approval, and publication of this ordinance:

1. Ordinance No#310.3 adopted by the Simpson Fiscal Court on June 11, 1996 is hereby repealed.
2. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

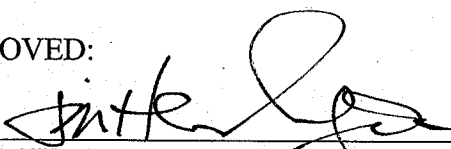

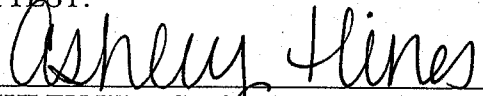
