AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE LEVY
OF A FLAT RATE CHARGE OF \$250.00
FOR FIRE RUNS MADE FOR THE BENEFIT
OF PROPERTY OWNERS LOCATED IN
SIMPSON COUNTY, KENTUCKY AND
PROVIDING FOR A LIEN TO SECURE
THE PAYMENT OF SAME

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF THE COUNTY OF SIMPSON, COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY, by virtue of authority vested in said fiscal court by KRS 67.083(3)(u), after the passage, approval and publication of this ordinance as fold:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby levied against every person, corporation, firm or entity for the benefit of whose real or personal property a fire run is made by the Simpson County Volunteer Fire Department outside the city limits of the City of Franklin a flat rate fee or charge of \$250.00, due and payable by such person, corporation, firm or entity within thirty (30) days after such fire run is made.

SECTION 2. That the County of Simpson, Commonwealth of Kentucky shall have a lien on the real or personal property for the benefit of which a fire run is made for the amount of said flat rate fee or charge, together with interest at the rate of twelve percent (12%) per annum from the date of the fire run until paid, plus any charges for towing and storage of motor vehicles.

SECTION 3. In the case of a motor vehicle for the benefit of which a fire run is made, the lien described in Section 2. hereinabove shall be enforced in all respects in the same manner

as a lien on motor vehicle as provided in KRS 376.270.

Specifically, the rights of the County of Simpson,
Commonwealth of Kentucky shall include, but shall not be limited
to, the right to detain, tow and store any motor vehicle for the
benefit of which a fire run is made until such time as all charges
set forth hereinabove have been paid in full.

SECTION 4. In the case of real property for the benefit of which a fire run is made, the lien described in Section 2. hereinabove shall be enforced in all respects in the same manner as a mechanic's and materialmen's lien as provided in KRS 376.010, et seq.

SECTION 5. All charges for fire runs made by the Simpson County Volunteer Fire Department shall be paid to the County Treasurer, who will render a statement of the charge to the owner of the property for whose benefit the fire run was made, and who will deposit all receipts to the general fund.
