Ordinance #310.8

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ADDRESS IDENTIFICATION BY NUMBER FOR PROPERTY LOCATED IN SIMPSON COUNTY, KENTUCKY

WHEREAS, it appears to be in the best interests of the citizens of Simpson County, Kentucky for all owners of residential, commercial or industrial property to have posted a recognizable street or road address identification by number in order to facilitate property location by emergency service providers, law enforcement personnel and other government agencies.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF THE COUNTY OF SIMPSON,

COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY, as follows:

1. All persons or entities owning real property within Simpson County, Kentucky shall post their road or street address number on the front of their residential, commercial or industrial building, on the front side thereof, as close to the front entrance as possible, in numbers clearly visible, and at least three (3) inches in height. The numbers shall be posted in such a fashion as to be clearly visible from the street or road, and not obstructed by trees, bushes, signs, or similar objects.

2. In the event that a building is located at a such distance from the street or road that said numbers are not clearly visible from the street or road, then said numbers shall be posted at or near the driveway entrance from the

property.

3. Any person or entity failing to comply with the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined not less than \$10.00, nor more than \$50.00, for each offense, and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues.

4. Upon receipt of report that any property owner does not have the address properly posted, the Sheriff shall immediately notify the property owner in writing to comply with the terms and provisions of this ordinance. The property owner shall then have 14 days from receipt of the notice within which to comply with the request.

5. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.
