AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO COST RECOVERY FOR HAZORDOUS MATERIAL RESPONSE

WHEREAS, it appears to be in the best interests of Simpson County, Kentucky to adopt cost recovery procedures for expenses incurred by Simpson County, the Simpson County Volunteer Fire Department, other County agencies, or other emergency response teams responding to hazardous material releases;

- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF THE COUNTY OF SIMPSON, COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY, after the passage, approval, and publication of this ordinance, as follows:

 1. "Hazardous Material Response Cost Recovery Standards" incorporated herein by reference, are hereby adopted and shall have full force and effect.
 - If any section, subsection, sentence clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.
