AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE ZONING FROM
AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT A-1 TO HEAVY INDUSTRIAL I-2

WHEREAS, the Franklin Simpson Planning & Zoning Commission held a public hearing on June 2, 1987, and as a result thereof recommended to the Simpson County Fiscal Court that the tract of land containing 67 acres, of KAEC properties formerly Henry Broderson property for proposed lake, be rezoned from A-1 to I-2 which is as follows:

A tract of land containing 67 acres, more or less, of KAEC properties formerly Henry Broderson property for proposed lake and more particularly described in attached description.

WHEREAS, it is deemed for the best interests of the Citizens of Simpson County, Kentucky that said agricultural zoning classifications be changed;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Fiscal Court of the County of Simpson, Commonwealth of Kentucky that the property containing 67 acres, as described herein be rezoned from A-1 to I-2 for the development of a lake.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.
