

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING ZONING
MAP AMENDMENTS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF THE COUNTY OF SIMPSON,
KENTUCKY, after the passage, approval and publication of this
ordinance, pursuant to KRS 100.211, that the following zoning map
amendment recommended by the Franklin-Simpson Planning and Zoning
Commission have been approved and adopted:

- (1) Subject property consisting of 19.396 acres and situated on east side of 31W North at Warren County line, from A-1 (Agricultural) to I-2 (Heavy Industry) for the purpose of property to be sold to Kenny Milam of Triple K Construction to relocate paving business, as requested by Odell Sparks.

This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage, approval and publication. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.
