

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING ZONING

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF THE COUNTY OF SIMPSON,
KENTUCKY, after the passage, approval and publication of this
amendment recommended by the Franklin-Simpson Planning and
Zoning Commission have been approved and adopted:

(1) Subject property consisting of 7.6 acres
and situated on Hwy 31W South just north of
Tennessee line and near drive-in theater,
from I-2 (Heavy Industry) to B-2 (General
Business), for the purpose of development
of property for general business, as requested
by Jack Burnett.

This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage, approval,
and publication. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause,
phrase, or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid
or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such
portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent
provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the
remaining portions hereof,
