BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF THE COUNTY OF SIMPSON, KENTUCKY,  
after the passage, approval and publication of this zoning map amendment  
that same has been approved and adopted:

- (1) Subject property consisting of .54 acres, less  
any easements or rights of way of record, located  
on east side of 31-W South for a zone change from  
A-1 (agriculture) to B-2 (General Business) as  
requested by Carl B. and Winnie E. Stone.

This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage, approval and publication.  
If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this  
ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court  
of competent jurisdiction such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct,  
and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of  
the remaining portions hereof.
