

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT  
OF NEW FEES TO BE CHARGED BY THE  
FRANKLIN-SIMPSON PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF THE COUNTY OF  
SIMPSON, COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY, after the passage, approval, and  
publication of this ordinance as follows:

Any fee schedule which may have been previously adopted  
by the County of Simpson, Commonwealth of Kentucky, for the permits  
listed below is hereby repealed, and the following fees shall be  
assessed for said permits:

Heating, Ventilation, and Air Condition Unit (HVAC) Permits . . . . .	\$30.00 per HVAC installation plus \$10.00 per inspection

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or  
portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or  
unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such  
portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent  
provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the  
remaining portions hereof. All ordinances or parts of ordinances  
in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby  
repealed.
