

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE CREATION OF A DEVELOPMENT AREA BY SIMPSON COUNTY, KENTUCKY

WHEREAS, it appears to be in the best interests of the citizens of Simpson County, Kentucky to create a Development Area for economic development purposes; and, WHEREAS, the hereinafter-described site is a contiguous geographic area within Simpson County, Kentucky in which on or more economic projects are proposed to be located.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF THE COUNTY OF SIMPSON, COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY, after the passage, approval, and publication of this ordinance, as follows:

- 1. Pursuant to KRS 65.700, the following described contiguous geographic area within Simpson County, Kentucky in which one (1) or more economic projects are proposed to be located is hereby designated a Development Area for economic development purposes located approximately four miles north of Franklin, in Simpson County, Kentucky, known as the North Industrial Park.
2. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of the Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or separate, district, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a remaining portions hereof. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.
