SIMPSON COUNTY FISCAL COURT An ordinance relating to the creation of a County Cemetery Board

BE IT ORDAINED by the Fiscal Court of Simpson County, Kentucky:

WHEREAS, a new section of KRS Chapter 67 was created in the 2002 regular session of the Kentucky General Assembly to read "a county acting under the authority of this section may by ordinance create a county cemetery board that may apply to the Department for Local Government for grants to restore and maintain non-profit cemeteries that do not receive perpetual care funds pursuant to KRS 267.952, and the county cemetery boards shall meet three times annually in space provided by the fiscal court and shall have five members with no more than three representing the same political party. Members shall be appointed by the judge/executive with approval of the fiscal court, shall have lived in the county for at least one year prior to appointment, and shall have demonstrated an interest in cemetery preservation, genealogy, local history or a related area"; and

WHEREAS, the members of the Fiscal Court wish to create said cemetery board in order to apply for state assistance in the ongoing maintenance of the many non-profit cemeteries scattered throughout Simpson County;

NOW THEREFORE, the Simpson County Fiscal Court hereby creates by ordinance the Simpson County Cemetery Board for the purposes stated above as intended by acts created by the Kentucky General Assembly.

Approved on 1st reading by a motion by Larry Randolph Seconded by Charle MCytchen, passed 5 to 0, the 30th day of September 2003.
