COUNTY ORDINANCE

ORDINANCE NO. 940.0 - 1

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ADOPTION OF THE KENTUCKY BUILDING CODE AS PROMULGATED IN 815 KAR 7:010, 7:020 AND 7:030 BY THE BOARD OF HOUSING, BUILDINGS AND CONSTRUCTION OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY.

WHEREAS, KRS 198B.110(1) , requires that all buildings constructed in Simpson County shall be rebuilt in conformance with the uniform statebuilding code as adopted by the Board of Housing, Buildings and Construction, effective no later than August 15, 1981 and,

WHEREAS, KRS 67.380, KRS 67.410 and KRS 198B.110 authorize the Fiscal Court of Simpson County of the Commonwealth of Kentucky to adopt the Kentucky Building Code prior to the required effective date, as well as provide for the administration of said code; and,

WHEREAS, KRS 198B.010(5) authorizes any city, county or urban county government to extend, by ordinance, the application of the Kentucky Building Code to single family dwellings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF THE COUNTY OF Simpson, COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY;

SECTION ONE

THAT, the Kentucky Building Code as promulgated in 815 KAR 7:010, 7:020 by the Board of Housing, Buildings and Construction, Commonwealth of Kentucky, is hereby adopted in full as an Ordinance of Simpson County of the Commonwealth of Kentucky as if set out at length herein;

THAT, a copy of said Kentucky Building Code together with a copy of all other regulations or NFPA Pamphlets adopted or referred to thereunder, is on file in the Office of the Simpson County Clerk, and the Clerk shall be transmitted to the Department of Housing, Buildings and Construction of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

SECTION TWO

THAT, Simpson County Fiscal Court, shall be designated as the local enforcement agent for said Kentucky Building Code.

SECTION THREE

THAT, all ordinances, or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed/

SECTION FOUR

The application of the Kentucky Building Code Is hereby extended to all single family dwellings to be constructed in Simpson County.

SECTION FIVE

THAT, this resolution shall take effect and be in full force when passed, published and recorded according to law.
