Judge Barnes announced that the Chamber of Commerce Business After Hours will be held at the F-S High School this afternoon beginning at 3:30-5:00 and will be followed by the Steam Showcase which displays students' math and science projects.

Magistrate Downey reported that both the Parks and Boy & Girls Club boards met last week. He reported that spring baseball and softball season begins April 11th and the park will host a regional Little League tournament from June 24th July 2nd. Improvements will be made to the disc golf course before a disc golf tournament is held at the park May 21th. Earth Day activities scheduled at the park on Salurday, April 23nd from 10-2:00 and the Pride Festival will be held on June 4th at the old soccer complex. A rewrite of the event policy at the park will be reviewed and voted on by the Parks Board at the next meeting which will follow the new schedule of meeting regularly on the fourth Tuesday of each month at 6:00 PM. Items such as budget and comprehensive park operations and maintenance plans will be discussed and quotes for a security camera system are being received for review. He continued his reported with information delivered by OEM Director Robert Palmer that FEMA has approved the park for a grant for a storm shelter and future grants for more shelters are possible. Magistrate Downey said that a couple of more streets in the park will be named soon. Magistrate Downey continued with his report from the Boys & Girls Club Board meeting. The club will close the last day of school and reopen June 6th thru Auoust 19th.

Magistrate Chandler would like to have the state look at widening of some of the roads in the county particularly those providing comdors from 1-65 after a recent fatal accident and subsequent multi-vehicle fire on 1-65 created a major interruption of the normal flow of local traffic when the interstate was shut down for hours. He would also like Fiscal Court to send a letter to Kentucky Department of Fish & Wildlife requesting that a change be made of the zone number assignment for the quantity of deer allowed for hunters in Simpson County to a higher zone allotment like all surrounding counties. The current deer population has caused an increase in accidents resulting in property damage to vehicles and potential personal injury.

County Attorney Phillips encouraged those who have not yet paid their 2021 property taxes to do so before they are turned over to the County Clerk's Office and more fees are added. Sheriff Hopson explained that tax collection is the number one constitutional responsibility of the sheriff and was pleased to report that 98.5% of taxes, or \$15.1 million, have been collected to date with only \$230,000 left to be collected. He also explained that since the Sheriff's office will be closed on April 15th or Good Friday the tax deadline will be Monday, April 18th. Sheriff Hopson also announced that there will be three days (to be announced) for early voting for the May Primary from 8-4 at the Historic Courthouse and Tuesday, Election Day May 17th voting will be at the Historic Courthouse, the Ag Building at the Community Park and Simpson Elementary from 6 AM until 6 PM.

Regarding the recent accident and subsequent fiery crash on I-65, Fire Chief Leslie Goodrum clarified that the fatality occurred in the first accident around 4:00 AM. The multi-vehicle fire that came later on the interstate was the result of slowed or stopped traffic due to the first accident. Chief Goodrum expressed appreciation for the mutual aid of fireflighters from Portland, Woodburn and Alvaton that assisted with manpower, equipment and water and law enforcement assistance throughout the day. The consensus was that a discussion of funding for a full-time fire department needs to come soon.
