Magistrate Chandler questioned Jailer Eric Vaughn why every county department except for the jail uses Go To Communications as their phone system. Judge Barnes inquired about cost savings and commented on the convenience of transferring calls between departments. IT Operations Adam Wilshire explained there wouldn't be much cost savings due to the amount of phones the jail would need.

Judge Barnes announced that the F-S Chamber of Commerce Member Appreciation Cookout will be September 29th from 11a-1p.

Judge Barnes informed the court of a payroll change notice received from the jail for a pay increase to a maintenance employee. Jailler Eric Vaughn explained that this employee replaced the former maintenance employee and his rate is \$1.00 cheaper than what they were paying. The new maintenance employee has assumed all the duties and more responsibilities resulting in the request of a pay increase. Jailer Eric Vaughn stated that this pay increase is within his budget.

Magistrate Poston reported that the striping on Broadway has faded. He recommended restriping that road at a quoted price from Scotty's Contracting for \$5,675.

Magistrate Downey announced that Parks and Recreation is working on getting together a drive-thru with Christmas light displays. He reported that soccer and fall ball programs will end this month with flag football beginning in October. Storm repairs are still in progress at the park and all had insurance coverage. Park Play is a monthly activity for homeschool children that will begin this month. BGCA is helping out with the Boys & Girls Club to help out find a CEO.

Magistrate Chandler commented on the drive-thru Christmas light displays and mentioned that Park Director Lisa Deavers is looking for sponsorships for that event starting at \$200. He also wanted the community to be aware and cautious of farm equipment on the roads this time of year.

County Attorney Sam Phillips thanked the community for their support of Rotary Club and the Reverse Raffle.

Jailer Eric Vaughn addressed a problem they're having at the jail with part-time employment currently being hired in at \$15/hr. He asked the court to reconsider and recommended hiring part-time employees starting at \$16 - \$16.50/hr to avoid using his full-time employees to fill in and having to pay them at an overtime rate. Judge Bames will run some numbers to determine the cost of overtime so far, this fiscal year. Jailer Eric Vaughn will provide the cost of training overtime so far, this fiscal year in order to have an accurate number.

Sheriff Jere Hopson announced that October starts tax collection and everyone should have their tax bills by first week of October. Tax bills are accessible online and the Sheriff's Office will begin collecting taxes in office on October 3<sup>rd</sup>.
