During his report Judge Barnes encouraged Fiscal Court and department heads to review the Information Technology & Cybersecurity Policies information which will be included in the County's Administrative Code by ordinance. He reiterated that to maintain the county's cybersecurity insurance with KACo compliance with these policies is necessary. He reported that he had received notice that the City recently completed the annexation of 26 acres located on Blackjack Road (KY 1171) between Blackjack Road and North Street by Ordinance No. 2023-003. He announced that a regular joint city/county meeting would convene at City Hall at noon on this date. His report continued with information regarding the volume of storm debris from the recent wind event when the Kummer Weather station reportedly recorded up to 80 mph wind. A manned public disposal area will be designated to accept only vegetative materials at a site on Kenneth Utley Drive beginning Saturday, March 11th from 8-4. He announced the Agriculture Appreciation Breakfast will be at the Franklin First United Methodist Church CLC, Tuesday, March 14th at 7:00 AM with Ag Commissioner Ryan Quarles (also a gubernatorial candidate) as keynote speaker who will also be at a meet and greet at Just Piddlin' Farm Monday evening, March 13th. Jonathan Shell, former Kentucky State Representative, who is running for Ag Commissioner will be at the Roxy at noon on Monday, March 13th.

Authorize providing and managing a manned site for vegetative debris disposal for Simpson County residents with the site to be located on Kenneth Utley Drive with up to two employees for up to six to eight weeks or longer if needed.

Sheriff Hopson offered his appreciation for all who assisted during the wind event on Friday, March 3rd. Fire Chief Leslie Goodrum publicly expressed appreciation to those that helped the firefighters as they were pulled in so many directions and were meeting the obstacles of downed trees and power lines in their attempts to respond to the numerous emergencies. When a house fire erupted and was exacerbated by the extremely high winds and local firefighters were scattered throughout the county on multiple types of emergencies, Woodburn Fire came to the aid of Franklin Simpson Fire Rescue and citizens stepped in as well.

Facilities Maintenance Supervisor Bill Rohrs reported that the standing seam roof on the Goodnight House was rolled up by the windstorm and the Sanford Duncan Inn sign was blown from its location across HWY-31W into a field.

County Attorney Sam Phillips encouraged citizens to pay their property taxes before they go into delinquency status. He also reported that he had reviewed the proposed Information Technology policy and recommended some minor changes.
