At a regular meeting of the Simpson County Fiscal Court held in the Courtroom of the Simpson County Historic Courthouse, Tuesday, June 6, 2023, at 8:30 AM

County Judge Executive Mason Barnes called the fiscal court meeting to order, and Magistrate Poston opened with prayer followed by the pledge to the American flag.

Kentucky Kids on the Block representatives, Missi Carini and Amanda Guerra, presented information about the programs for children that the organization offers to schools and, even though, they realized that budget preparation time has passed for this year, they wanted to inform Fiscal Court and, hopefully, when the next budget cycle comes around, a contribution to help support more programs in the three Simpson County elementary schools will be possible. The current cost per program is \$450 and provides education and prevention using child life-size puppetry on topics such as acceptance of disabilities and differences, substance awareness and child abuse. The consensus of the court was to investigate jointly supporting more KOB programs for local elementary schools with the City of Franklin and Simpson County Schools.

Approve the appointment of Brandon Duffer to the Franklin-Simpson Ambulance Board to fill the unexpired term of Hunter Bowen from July 1, 2023, thru December 31, 2023.

Motion by Chandler Second by Poston Yes-Chandler, Poston & Barnes No-Burr & Thurman  
Approve second reading and final passage of Ordinance No. 140.04 approving and authorizing the amended Memorandum of Understanding/Interlocal Cooperation Agreement for Providing and Funding School Resource Officers for Each School in the Franklin-Simpson School System and authorizing the signature of Judge Executive Mason Barnes.

Motion by Thurman Second by Chandler Yes-All  
Approve and authorize the signature of Judge Executive Mason Barnes on the *Waiver of Notice of Intent to Consensually Annex Property and Concurrence of Simpson Fiscal Court* for the annexation of a certain 1.184-acre parcel of land in the Henderson Industrial Park adjacent to property already owned and occupied by Precision Power, LLC.

Approve *Amendment to Amended, Supplemented, and Restated Grant Contract Regarding the East Industrial Development Area and Henderson Industrial Park* which amends the Grant Contract for the Industrial Authority that rather than receive 100% of the occupational tax from Tractor Supply operations and 80% of all other occupational tax in the Sanders and Henderson parks, effective July 1, 2023, the Authority will receive 100% of ¾% of occupational tax from new revenue of Tractor Supply and 70% of ¾% of occupational tax from the remainder of Sanders and Henderson parks and authorize the signature of County Judge Executive Mason Barnes. \*It was noted that this does not increase occupational tax merely the percentage split of this tax revenue.

Approve *Amendment to Amended, Supplemented, and Restated Grant Contract Regarding the North Industrial Development Area* which amends the Grant Contract for the Industrial Authority that rather than receive 100% of occupational tax from Fritz Winter and 80% of all other occupational tax in the Wilkey North Industrial Park, effective July 1, 2023, the Authority will receive 100% of ¾% of occupational tax from Fritz Winter until the Authority has been reimbursed the value of the land and it shall receive 70% of ¾% of occupational tax from the remainder of Wilkey Industrial Park and authorize the signature of County Judge Executive Mason Barnes. \*It was noted that this does not increase occupational tax merely the percentage split of this tax revenue.

Adopt Resolution 2023-06-06JAIL authorizing the filing of Kentucky House Bill (HB) 1 Jail Arraignment Equipment Grant application for up to \$36,595.00 in HB1 project funds with the Department for Local Government (DLG); authorizing and directing the Simpson County Judge/Executive to execute any documents which are deemed necessary by DLG to carry out this project; and authorizing the Judge/Executive to act as the authorized correspondent for this project. \*This is for equipment to provide a more secure video network AOC now has in place.

Authorize A&M Consultants to put together an employee survey for departments of Simpson County Fiscal Court to "access the concerns and attitudes of employees related to their workplace environment, team productivity, and task motivation" for a price quote of \$7,800 and authorize the signature of Judge Executive Barnes to effectuate this process.

Approve the renewal of employee health insurance benefits with Anthem/KACO plan options (premium and standard) with a decrease in cost of employee and employee/children premium plan, a decrease in cost of employee standard plan and slight increase in cost of employee/children standard plan with \$900 county contribution per month per employee for the FY23/24 and to allocate \$1,500 for an HRA per employee per year for those with an Anthem plan and allocate \$500 per year toward optional health benefits for employees who waive the primary health insurance coverage offered by the County and authorize Judge Executive Mason Barnes to sign any documents necessary to effectuate this motion.

Authorize the renewal agreement with McGregor and Associates as Simpson County Fiscal Court benefits administrators for the FY23/24 and authorize the signature of Judge Executive Mason Barnes to sign any necessary documents for this agreement to be fully executed.

Motion by Burr Second by Chandler Yes-Burr, Chandler, Thurman & Barnes Abstain-Poston  
Authorize continuing to offer Dental benefits through Delta Dental with no changes to the plan and authorize the signature of Judge Executive Barnes on necessary documents.

Authorize the AirMed Care Network Group Full Census Membership (air Evac air ambulance) as well as renewal of Life and Disability insurance with no changes and authorize Judge Executive Mason Barnes to sign any necessary documents associated with these benefits.

Accept the FY23/24 asphalt bid from Scotty's Contracting and Stone, LLC, as listed. (This was the only bid received.)

- 1. Bituminous Concrete Surface for resurfacing roads in place anywhere in Simpson County. The bid will include tack oil, .05/gallon per square yard, and heeling back shoulders, including any necessary grade work to prepare for asphalt surface. Total price per ton: \$98.50
1A. Bituminous Concrete Surface for resurfacing roads, picked up at the plant by County. Total price per ton: \$95.51
2. Bituminous Concrete Base for resurfacing roads in place anywhere in Simpson County. The bid will include tack oil, .05/gallon per square yard, and heeling back the shoulders and removing debris from yards, including any necessary grade work to prepare for asphalt base. Total price per ton: \$92.30
2A. Bituminous Concrete Base for resurfacing roads, picked up at the plant by County. Total price per ton: \$92.70
3. Trenching Per Linear Foot: The bidder will excavate a trench approximately 3" in depth and a width of approximately 18" each side of roadway. Placing bituminous concrete base in trench and compacting shall be paid for as per ton bid price for bituminous concrete base. The cost of removing excess material from excavated areas will be incidental to bid item of trenching per linear foot. Total price per ton: \$1.50
4. DGA for shoulders in place, on a "per ton basis". Simpson County will have the option in which roads are to receive a DGA shoulder. Total price per ton: \$28.50
5. Ditching & Shouldering: The bidder will ditch and shoulder various roads in Simpson County as directed by the County. Fill material, removing and replacing mailboxes, and installing driveway intersection pipe shall be incidental to the bid. The cost of new pipe shall be quoted at a unit price per job. Total price per linear foot: \$7.50
6. Seeding & Protection: The bidder will seed and straw ditches & shoulders along various roads in Simpson County as directed by the County. Total price per square yard: \$1.75
7. Pavement Striping - Permanent: The bidder will stripe various roads in Simpson County as directed by the County. Total price per linear foot: \$0.40

Authorize advertising for bids through Arnold Consulting Engineering Services for the replacement of the existing low water crossing on Kenny Perry Drive.

Public Works Director Bobby Groves presented a lengthy list of roads for approval of proposed speed limits for those county roads. The process of changing speed limits has been for the magistrate of that magisterial district to make the request for approval by Fiscal Court and followed up by ordinance. Director Groves would like to establish uniform guidelines for setting speed limits to be consistent and reported that the state suggests that residential streets be 35 or 45 mph and undivided highways be 55 mph.

Approve setting and posting of a 20-mph speed limit for Coomes Lane, Groves Lane, Groves Road, Skeritt Street and Westfield Lane and a 25-mph speed limit for Autumn Lane, Cambridge Station Road, Coates Road, Country View Lane, Creekwood Drive, Crestview Drive, Crow Avenue, Dew Drop Drive, Drew Brooke Drive, East Bridge Road, First Avenue East, First Avenue West, Fitzgerald Court, Fremont Lane, Holly Hills Road, Holly Tree Court, Jenny Locke Run, Joe Leslie Farmer Road, Molly Avenue, Oak Hills Lane, Second Avenue East, Second Avenue West, Spence Lane, Stephens Hill Road, Third Avenue East, Third Avenue West, White Oak Lane, Wilson Way, and Windy Circle as presented by Public Works Director Bobby Groves.
\*This motion will become effective following the passage of an ordinance establishing these speed limits.

Authorize lowering speed limit to 45 mph on Craft Road, Hack Brown Road and Johns Loop Road as requested by East Magistrate Chandler.
\*This motion will become effective following the passage of an ordinance combining the road list from the previous motion with these three roads.

The next discussion was to address an Administrative Code revision as proposed with Ordinance No. 230.30 which included changes to Section 3.13 Status of Employment and 3.45 Leave and the addition of Chapter 8, INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY/CYBER SECURITY which will be required to maintain KACo cyber security insurance. As consideration of the revisions began, Magistrate Burr reminded the court that he had tabled a part of this discussion at a previous meeting which after legal counsel reviewed, it was found that it was at the January 17th fiscal court meeting and was tabled until the February 21st meeting but was not taken up at that meeting. These proposed revisions may be viewed in this meeting's attachment file in yellow highlight.

Take the motion off the table from the January 17th meeting when Magistrate Burr made the motion to table Agenda Item No. 8 (Administrative Code Amendment) until the February 21st meeting and Magistrate Poston seconded that motion followed by a unanimous vote in favor of tabling that January 17th discussion, however, this discussion was not taken back up at that February 21st meeting. (Reference Order Book 16, Page 482, for the tabling motion on January 17th and minutes of the February 21st, Pages 489-492 meeting do not record any action taking that motion off the table.)

Motion by Chandler Second by Barnes Yes-Chandler, Barnes & Poston No-Burr & Thurman
Approve first reading of Ordinance No. 230.30 revising Administrative Code Section 3.13: Status of Employment as follows:

- A. All employees shall be designated as full-time, part-time, seasonal, or temporary.
1. Full-time employee - An employee who works 35 hours per week or more on a regular basis.
2. Part-time employee - An employee who works less than 35 hours per week on a regular scheduled basis.
3. Seasonal employee - An employee who works in a position which is of a seasonal nature (full-time or part-time) and works no more than nine (9) months during a fiscal year.
4. Temporary employee - An employee who is brought in to work on a specific task for a defined time period.
5. Regardless of employment status, all employees will be compensated by either an hourly rate or annual salary as set by the Fiscal Court.
B. Only full-time or part-time employees may occupy established positions.
C. Full-time employees shall be entitled to all benefits provided by Simpson County. Employees may be entitled to health insurance benefits, even if in a position designated at less than full-time, depending on applicable federal law.
D. No County employee, full or part time, shall be employed by an outside vendor or supplier of goods and/or services to the County department or office within which they work.

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### Section 3.45: Parental Leave

- A. Maternity leave may be granted for full-time employees with temporary disability due to pregnancy, childbirth, or any impairment thereof, and miscarriages for a period not to exceed twelve (12) weeks. Up to six (6) weeks of maternity leave shall be with pay. The employee may use accrued leave, any compensatory time (if applicable) and the remaining period off without pay.
- B. Two weeks of paid paternity leave may be granted to full-time employees upon the birth of their child.
- C. Two weeks of paid parental leave may be granted to full-time employees upon the adoption of a child.
