

ORDINANCE NO. 110.9

AN ORDINANCE PURSUANT TO KRS 67.045 ADOPTING THE REPORT OF THE REAPPORTIONMENT COMMISSION AND REESTABLISHING THE BOUNDARY LINES OF THE EXISTING MAGISTRATE'S DISTRICTS, ADOPTING A MAP OF SAME AND FIXING COMPENSATION OF REAPPORTIONMENT COMMISSIONERS.

WHEREAS, KRS 67.045(2) requires that the Fiscal Court of Simpson County, Kentucky, maintain each Magistrate's district in a manner so that each such district be drawn so that the districts are compact, contiguous and the population of each district is nearly equal as possible; and

WHEREAS, KRS 67.045(4) requires that the Fiscal Court initiate reapportionment proceedings in May of the first year following the decennial census of the United States and at other times as appropriate; and

WHEREAS, that the Fiscal Court of Simpson County has appointed as Reapportionment Commissioners Gary Dunning, Bobby "Chip" Phillips, James Henry Snider and Austin Johnson, Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the Reapportionment Commission filed its report with the Simpson Fiscal Court on July 3, 2023, indicating that existing Magistrates' Districts are not as equal as possible and therefore recommending changes in such districts.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it **ORDAINED** by the Fiscal Court of Simpson County, Kentucky, that the findings of fact and recommendations of the Reapportionment Commission, consisting of Gary Dunning, Bobby "Chip" Phillips, and James Henry Snider, all being citizens of Simpson County, Kentucky, over the age of 21 years, and Austin Johnson, Clerk of Simpson County, Kentucky, said report being presented to the Fiscal Court on July 5, 2023 and attached hereto as Exhibit A, is hereby adopted, ratified and incorporated herein as if set forth in full, and

the boundaries of the two (2) Magistrates' Districts shall be modified to the boundaries as recommended in such report attached hereto as collective Exhibit B, is hereby **ADOPTED**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED AND ORDERED that said Commissioners, exclusive of the County Clerk, be paid the sum of \$100.00 by the County Treasurer for their services.

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED that the advertisement of the consideration of this Ordinance, published in accordance with KRS Chapter 424, shall notify any registered voter of Simpson County, Kentucky, that an action may be brought before the Simpson Circuit court to reverse the provisions of the reapportionment within twenty days of the adoption hereof.

Given first reading on July 18th, 2023 and thereafter given second reading and unanimously adopted this 1st day of August, 2023.

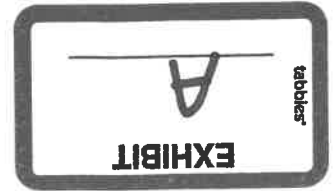
