

ORDINANCE NO. 530.61

**AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO A REDUCTION IN THE
SPEED LIMIT ON CERTAIN COUNTY ROADS**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF THE COUNTY OF SIMPSON,
COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY, after the passage, approval and publication of this
ordinance as follows:

1. Pursuant to KRS 189.390(5)(a), the speed limit of the following county roads shall
be 20 miles per hour:

Coomes Lane	Skerritt Street
Groves Lane	Westfield Lane
Groves Road	

2. Pursuant to KRS 189.390(5)(a), the speed limit of the following county roads shall
be 25 miles per hour:

Autumn Lane	Holly Tree Court
Cambridge Station Road	James Avenue
Coates Road	Jenny Locke Run
Country View Lane	Joe Leslie Farmer Road
Creekwood Drive	Molly Avenue
Crestview Drive	Oak Hills Lane
Crow Avenue	Second Avenue East
Dew Drop Drive	Second Avenue West
Drew Brooke Drive	Spence Lane
East Bridge Road	Stephens Hill Road
First Avenue East	Third Avenue East
First Avenue West	Third Avenue West
Fitzgerald Court	White Oak Lane
Freemont Lane	Wilson Way
Holly Hills Road	Windy Circle

3. Pursuant to KRS 189.390(5)(a), the speed limit of Kenny Perry Drive from Hwy.
73 for a distance of 3,700 feet shall be 35 miles per hour.

4. Pursuant to KRS 189.390(5)(a), the speed limit of the following county roads shall
be 45 miles per hour:

Craft Road
Hack Brown Road
Johns Loop Road
Kenny Perry Drive from Peden Mill Road for 5,978 feet

5. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.
