At a regular meeting of the Simpson County Fiscal Court held in the Courtroom of the Simpson County Historic Courthouse, Tuesday, August 15, 2023, at 8:30 AM

County Judge Executive Mason Barnes called the fiscal court meeting to order and led in prayer followed by the pledge to the American flag.

Tourism Director Amy Ellis shared information from a 2022 Economic Impact of Tourism In Kentucky that she recently received at a press conference featuring Governor Andy Beshear in Lexington. In the ten-county Barren River Area Development District, also referred to in tourism terms as the \*Caves, Lakes & Corvettes Region\* which include Allen, Barren, Butler, Edmonson, Hart, Logan, Metcalf, Monroe, Simpson and Warren counties, Warren County followed by Barren and then Simpson were the top three in tourism numbers and dollars in 2022 for this region. She reported that the cabin which was the previous location of the Tourism office is currently under contract for sale and she hopes to be in the new location on West Cedar Street in six months following completion of its renovation. Judge Barnes expressed appreciation to Director Ellis for Tourism agreeing to take on the 60th anniversary year of the Franklin Car Show in conjunction with the Franklin Festival in September.

Emergency Management Director Robert Palmer reported that regarding the safe room planned for the community park has made little progress as is typical with Hazard Miligation Grants. He is waiting for the contract from KYEM to be signed so they can move on to getting a design and engineering for the shelter at the park and he announced, unofficially, that another \$600,000 grant for a safe room for the west side of the city is coming. Also, he reported that the radio communication tower went up last week and a contractor is currently working on the foundation for the building and generator pad which will be followed by construction of the building in October at the tower site. Director Palmer anticipates that radio equipment will be delayed because KSP will not be where they need to be by the time local equipment is ready.

Approve July 31,2023 financial statement subject to audit and authorize signatures of Treasurer Nicole Law and Judge Executive Mason Barnes.

Judge Barnes reported that A&M Consulting will have the county employee survey available August 21st through August 31st. Judge Barnes will send the link to the county department heads via email for them to get to their employees and employees' responses will go directly to the consulting firm. His report continued with the announcement that Toyo Automotive Parts (USA), Inc./TMM-USA, Inc. (Toyo/TMM) will close its facility located at 521 Page Drive on October 31, 2023. Judge Barnes commented that closures such as this are inevitable from time to time and is a reason that he supports continuing industry recruitment for this community. An acknowledgement and letter of appreciation from SKYCTC for the county's support of the On-track Scholarship Program was shared by Judge Barnes. He also announced that \$120,000 from a hazard mitigation grant has been awarded for elevation work on Kummer Road. Due to scheduling conflict for the Franklin City Commission, the regular joint city/county meeting on September 19th will be rescheduled with the date to be determined. Topics to be discussed will include the Comprehensive Plan particularly regarding P&Z regulations, fire department, mutually agreed upon joint meeting dates and the Scott Waste contract. The consensus of the court was to determine dates for an ordinance setting regular meeting dates twice a year for joint meetings.

Magistrate Scott Poston as Parks Board member reported that the process of starting fall ball has begun and as Boys and Girls Club Board member, he had attended the ribbon-cutting at the Allen County Boys and Girls Club which is under the umbrella of the Franklin Simpson Boys and Girls Club.

Magistrate Marty Chandler reported that the Life Jacket Loaner Station has been put up at the Boat Ramp on Drakes Creek. As Chairman of the Equipment Committee, Magistrate Chandler reported from the meeting with his committee that Jailer Vaughn wants to surplus a couple of vehicles and Public Works as well. Any other departments interested in selling some vehicles should turn that information into the County Judge Executive's office by August 25th so a list can be available at the September 5th fiscal court meeting for approval to surplus. The method of sale will likely be through an auction company.

In response to a request by Fiscal Court to review the Scott Waste joint city/county contract, County Attorney Sam Phillips reported that problems with trash collection by Scott Waste should be specific and well documented and that Scott waste must be notified of those problems or breaches and be given thirty days to make correction before any action could be taken. The main complaint is two-fold in that trash does not get collected perhaps for a week or sometimes two but then there is never a billing adjustment for the skipped week or two. Magistrate Thurman reported that he had spoken with Scott Waste Services Operations Supervisor Trey Holman, and he was not aware of problems but would investigate the matter. When it's time to negotiate a new contract, fiscal court members would like to have a performance clause included in the terms. Attorney Philips reminded the court that at least ninety days' notice will be required before June 30, 2026, if they do not want this contract to be automatically renewed as it is.

Jailer Eric Vaughn again asked about the additional payroll changes that he had requested but after discussion there was no action taken and the 6.5% pay increase that had been previously approved for county employees remained unchanged.

Fire Chief Leslie Goodrum reported that a 2000 Pierce Freightliner fire truck has been purchased through GovDeals at a cost of \$42,00 with 12 1/2% buyer's premium for total cost of \$47,250.
