

ORDINANCE NO. 120.02

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 120.01 SETTING FORTH THE DATES AND TIMES OF REGULARLY SCHEDULED JOINT MEETINGS OF THE FRANKLIN CITY COMMISSION AND SIMPSON COUNTY FISCAL COURT

WHEREAS, members of the City Commission for the City of Franklin, Kentucky and the Fiscal Court of Simpson County, Kentucky are desirous of setting forth regularly scheduled joint meetings on a semi-annual basis and,

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Court has heretofore passed an ordinance establishing the meeting place and time for the joint meetings, and the Board of City Commissioners and members of the Simpson County Fiscal Court now desires to change said meeting times and places with respect to joint meetings only;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Franklin, Kentucky and the Fiscal Court of Simpson County, Kentucky that the Board of the City Commissioners shall hold regular joint meetings at 9:00 A.M. with the Simpson County Fiscal Court on the second Monday in the month of March and at 12:00 noon on the third Tuesday in the month of October each year. The March meetings shall take place in the Meeting Room of Franklin City Hall, 117 West Cedar Street, Franklin, Kentucky, and the October meetings shall take place in the Courtroom of the Simpson County Historic Courthouse on the public square in Franklin, Kentucky.

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion to this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holdings shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of Ordinance.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.
