At a special-called meeting of the Simpson County Fiscal Court held in the Courtroom of the Simpson County Historic Courthouse, Tuesday, June 25, 2024, at 8:30 AM

County Judge Executive Mason Barnes called the fiscal court meeting to order and led in prayer followed by the pledge to the American flag.

Tourism Director Amy Ellis shared a power-point presentation of the 2023 tourism economic impact numbers and some of the current tourism promotional advertising campaigns for Franklin, Simpson County. Director Ellis reminded folks that tourism funding is generated from a three percent transient tax (hotel tax), and she reported that the "log cabin" at Exit 6, that formerly housed the tourism office, has been sold and framing of the new office space at 105 West Cedar Street is underway. This year's Fourth of July Fireworks display at The Mint Gaming Hall is scheduled for Tuesday, July 2nd

Executive Director at Barren River District Health Department, Dr. Matt Hunt, and Kim Flora attended this meeting to share information regarding the Health Department and services that it can provide for the public as well as how the health department tax works if separated from the county's general fund. Dr. Hunt listed areas of public health that as required by KRS's must be provided such as disease management, community health needs assessments, environmental services such as inspections of septic systems, restaurants and public pools, disaster response in tandem with Emergency Management, mass immunization management for disease mitigation, of septic systems, restact and such public poors, diseased response in lander will client gently managed in the second supplemental nutrition programs, dental programs in the schools and social workers going into homes to hopefully change the trajectory of those families with challenging circumstances. He explained that in June of 1988 the Kentucky legislature created public health taxing districts for all 120 counties, but it is required by each county to adopt or implement a resolution. The Commissioner for Public Health, Dr. Steven Stack, at the state level sets the floor for the public health contribution rate. The minimum contribution rate is 1.8 cents per \$100 of assessed value but no one in the state is operating at this low rate. The Barren River District rate is 2.25 cents per \$100 with the state average being 4.66 cents per \$100 and the ceiling is 10 cents per \$100. The Berren River District counties of Hart, Metcalf and Simpson have not established public health taxing districts and fund their health department obligation with their general funds. His recommendation, if considering establishment of a health department taxing district, is to set the rate at 2.5 cents per \$100 by resolution by the first of September and take the first and second quarters of that first fiscal year from the General Fund as taxing district is initially established and then the third and fourth quarters could come from taxes that would have gone out in the fall. He reiterated that funding of the health department is required by law.

Kentucky Legislature signed medical cannabis into law March 31, 2023, with Senate Bill 47 and it is now part of KRS 218. The law will be effective January 1, 2025, with the licensing application process beginning July 1, 2024, with five types of licenses which include cultivator, processor, producer, safety compliance and dispensary, all issued and regulated at the state level. There was no action regarding this matter since only discussion of this subject was on this special-called agenda.
