At a regular meeting of the Simpson County Fiscal Court held in the Courtroom of the Simpson County Historic Courthouse, Tuesday, June 4, 2024, at 8:30 AM

County Judge Executive Mason Barnes called the fiscal court meeting to order, and County Attorney Sam Phillips led in prayer followed by the pledge to the American flag.

Joe Plunk, Casey Pedigo, Justin Young and Wes Watt with District Three Kentucky Transportation Cabinet attended this meeting to present the FY24/25 Rural Secondary Program (KRS 177.330) of the FY24/25 projected allotment of \$912,951.00 plus FY23/24 balance carryover of \$101,522.00 providing total funds available of \$1,014,473.00. Forty-two percent of these funds amounting to approximately \$383,400.00 will be used for routine maintenance and traffic on 95.575 miles of rural secondary roads, \$3,875.00 will be used for county judge expenses, \$490,255.00 will be used to resurface 2.713 miles of KY 621 (Stevenson RD) from intersection with Robertson RD at MP 5.755 to intersection with US 31W at MP 8.468. Flex funds in the amount of \$136,943.00 will be available for county flex projects. Brainstorming and discussions among the engineers and court members regarding remedies for some traffic problem areas as well as updates on some projects currently in progress followed the presentation.

Cancel the June 18th regular Fiscal Court meeting and schedule a Special-called Fiscal Court meeting for Tuesday, June 25th at 8:30 AM to comply with the required public notice for second reading and final passage of FY24/25 Budget Ordinance No. 220.257.

The consensus of Fiscal Court was to decline the sponsorship of a family values booklet for first graders. Judge Barnes continued his report by reminding the court to review and consider the 60-page presentation regarding medical cannabis as its legalization in Kentucky becomes effective January 1, 2025. This will be a topic of fiscussion at the June 25th special-called Fiscal Court meeting. County employees were reminded that benefit informational meetings will be held Thursday, June 6th at 8:00, 10:30 and 1:30 and open enrollment will be Friday, June 7th in the Historic Courthouse Fiscal Courtroom.

Vagistrate Chandler, as Fiscal Court's representative, presented a brief report from a recent audit of the Franklin Simpson Industrial Authority. He reported that the ndustrial Authority saw a net asset increase from \$9.2 million to \$9.8 million from 2022 to 2023. Long-term debt is right at \$20 million which is down almost \$900,000 with \$5 million of the Authority's debt being carried on the County's books which are bonded at a low interest rate and the buildings, land and leases cover the rest.

Attorney Sam Phillips reminded delinquent taxpayers that the tax sale will be in September, and he encouraged them to pay them in full at the County Clerk's Office r visit his office to arrange for installment payments to avoid more fees and penalties.

ludge Barnes reported that the Safe Room at the Park is still in the design review stage.
