Judge Barnes reported that FY23 audit report is on the portal for review. It was a good audit but with the usual segregation of duties comments when the number of staff members can never seem to satisfy the auditors' standard. County Clerk Building Design Team and Sunbelt Construction met with county officials last week to discuss the beginning of the County Clerk/PVA building construction. It was reported that the electrical main distribution panel has a 35-week lead time. That is what can hold up progress the most but does not necessarily have to go in until later in the construction. This panel is to be ordered. The bar joist and deck are about a three-month lead time. Ground-breaking is projected to take place in mid to late October. Judge Barnes reminded folks that the annual Franklin car show is scheduled for Saturday, September 21st.

A special-called fiscal court meeting will be held Monday, September 9 at 8:30 AM to consider bids which are due by September 6th for the Neely Road culvert replacement and award the bid for this project. Neely Road had to be closed due to it collapsing at the culvert.

Magistrate Chandler commended the Public Works Department for their response in removing a tree from across a road when he'd received a call from a constituent. He also recognized and thanked F-S Fire Rescue for about a 14-hour day recently on the scene of a grain dryer fire at the elevator near the intersection of East Washington and Railroad streets. Chief Leslie Goodrum expressed appreciation to all county and city departments that help by blocking streets and keeping firefighters hydrated as they remained on scene throughout the 100-degree day along with EMS on standby for rehab for firefighters. Aubum Fire Department brought their 105-root aerial which was helpful to have the greater extension beyond F-S Fire Rescue's 75-foot aerial truck. Judge Barnes passed along a message of appreciation from grain elevator owner, Randy Mann. Magistrate Chandler encouraged the jailer and emergency management to have an emergency evacuation plan for the jail particularly considering this recent event.

Regarding the dry conditions, while a burn ban has not been imposed at this time, Chief Goodrum encouraged citizens to use extreme caution, inform Dispatch at 270.782.2010 if you plan to burn, stay with the burn, have a water source or a means of extinguishing a fire, burn only natural vegetation and if burning within the city limits, call Fire Department at 270.586.7174 for a burn permit.
