At a regular meeting of the Simpson County Fiscal Court held in the Courtroom of the Simpson County Historic Courthouse, Tuesday, November 19, 2024, at 8:30 AM

Present: Honorable Mason Bames, Judge/Executive Honorable Jeffrey Burr, West Madistrate Honorable Marty Chandler, East Magistrate Honorable Scott Poston, North Magistrate Honorable Myron Thurman, South Magistrate Honorable Sam Phillips, County Attorney Nicole Law, Treasurer Sydney Downey, Fiscal Court Clerk

County Judge Executive Mason Barnes called the fiscal court meeting to order with prayer by Magistrate Poston, followed by the pledge to the American flag.

Judge Barnes introduced the court to Candy & Liam Wentz with the 4-H Homeschool Club, and Stacie King; the recently hired Administrative Assistant in the Judge Executives office.

Guest speakers Robby Smith with Motorola, Gary Vance with KSP, Belden Perry and Kevin Yaden with Mobile Communications of America to discuss timeline for the communication equipment and answer any questions. Smith stated the statewide systems are not where they planned to be due to delays related to microwave, backhaul, and other system errors. Post one and two currently have some test users on it but haven't released all to KSP. A definite timeframe still isn't established for Simpson County, plan on giving radios to be tested in fringe areas first to see how their service is working before KSP gets involved.

Magistrate Marty Chandler expressed his frustration on the current timeframe of additional months, as the county spent three million dollars on a communication system that they are already two years into and it's still not up and running. Gary Vance with KSP expressed how they are working to get everything speed up and our region is the next get setup as we were the first committed add-on.

Questions about the warranty on the radios were mentioned. The court had heard the warranty takes effect the day they activate the radio and is good for seven years. Smith said the warranty goes into effect the day they take possession. Judge Barnes suggested extending the warranty of the radios for seven years through the time they are put on the system. Smith indicated that wasn't an unreasonable ask and he would ask and get the court an answer.

Judge Executive Barnes shared discussions that took place at the Industrial Authority Board Meeting. The Gann Farm is up for auction this upcoming weekend; the board was asked if they had a number in mind, they would be willing to bid; they decided not to proceed with a bid. The property is zoned AG (Agriculture) and the City Manager states it cannot be rezoned, as it is not in the future land use map and the comprehensive plan has taken full effect. If the court has more concerns about the land use map, they will have to take it up with the Planning & Zoning Commission Board.

Medical Cannabis was passed in Franklin with 71% in favor of it. The county can put an ordinance in place for future expansions with the five license types: cultivator, processor, producer, safety compliance facility, or dispensary. XYZ Facility in Franklin applied for a processors license, but didn't win from the lottery process.

Judge Barnes reminded the court and public that the annual Lions Club pancake fry will be this Saturday, November 23th at the high school cafeteria. Small Business Saturday is Thanksgiving weekend. There are roughly twenty items on the surptus sale, Mills Auction have come and took pictures just waiting for the auction date to be established. The Daughters of the American Revolution have requested to have Revolutionary War plaque displayed courthouse and will have a dedication ceremony in February. Judge Barnes wished everyone a Happy Thanksgiving.

Magistrate Jeffery Burr informed the public about the new director at the Boys & Girls Club of Franklin Simpson, she has many new ideas and fundraising opportunities

Magistrate Myron Thurman wished everyone a Happy Thanksgiving.
